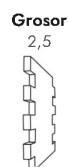
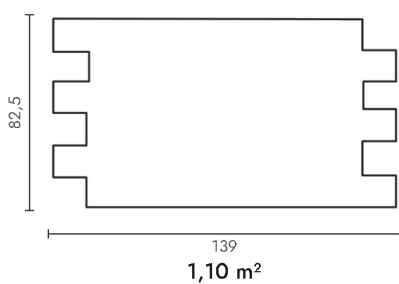

MSA-60 · Antracita joint filler

1 cartridge / 1 panel

PTX-86 · Gris Ceniza paint

1 paint / 8 panels

OPTIONAL

MSA-3 · Pegado filler

1 cartridge / 4 panels

Each finish has its own joint filler and paints: the products in the table are those for the colour chosen. Coverage figures are approximate and for guidance only. The MSA-3 bonding filler is only needed if the panel is bonded to the wall instead of screwed.

INTERIOR

PR grade panel: a 3–5 mm face layer of stone-based polymer concrete —reproducing the texture, the grain and the character of old, charred timber so faithfully it is indistinguishable from the original— over a second layer of open-cell high-density polyurethane that provides thermal and acoustic insulation and keeps damp out. It weighs very little and is tongue-and-groove, so it is fitted straight onto the existing surface, with no building work. For interiors.

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05 Installation

INSTALLATION

Fitting the Little Burned panel is straightforward: Remember panels are **jigsaw-style tongue-and-groove** and weigh very little, so they go **straight onto the existing surface, with no building work**. Prepare the wall, apply adhesive to the back, slot each panel into the previous one and reinforce with screws. Finish and fill the joints with the filler and paint for the finish.



1

Gather your materials

Drill, adhesive, spirit level, rule, plugs and screws.



2

Measure and level

A clean, dry and level wall.



3

Cut to size

With a saw or an angle grinder with a fine disc.



4

Apply adhesive

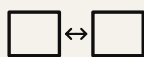
Beads of adhesive from top to bottom on the back of the panel.



5

Position the panel

Press the panel against the wall.



6

Fit the panels together

Join panel to panel, with no gaps.



7

Reinforce with screws

With the panels properly fitted, reinforce with 4-8 screws per panel.



8

Finish and fill

Fit the trim profiles, then fill and paint the joints.

IN OUR RESINS WE USE RECYCLED MATERIALS FROM PET PLASTIC BOTTLES.

En Paneles Decorativos PanelPiedra® utilizamos resinas de poliéster y poliuretano con una cantidad muy elevada de botellas de plástico recicladas.

Every square metre of our resin contains at least **1/3 recycled plastic bottles**.

2. Sustainable development

SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT

Our plant has water treatment systems and manual processes to avoid using more water than necessary.

Our raw material is 75 % recyclable: marble dust and quarry waste. We are concerned about pollution and about waste such as plastic, so we use recyclable cardboard for our packaging to help protect the land and the oceans, because marine biodiversity is vital to the health of people and of our planet.

We want to conserve nature, adapting every manufacturing process to minimise the impact of what we do on the environment.

We try to generate as little waste as possible by making the most of our raw materials. Panel thicknesses are carefully worked out to avoid unnecessary bulk, cutting waste without affecting design or quality.

Our products are built to last and can be repainted, which means the product itself can be recycled; they can also be taken down and refitted elsewhere, making them a **reusable product**.

RAW MATERIAL

Polyurethane, our raw material, has a set of properties that make our products work with the environment rather than against it.



4. Reducing energy consumption REDUCTION OF ENERGY CONSUMPTION

El poliuretano es un eficaz aislante térmico, proporcionando además aislamiento acústico. Los paneles decorativos de PanelPiedra® cuentan con el certificado de **Thermal insulation** under UNE standards. As effective insulators, they improve the energy efficiency of buildings and reduce the need for heating and cooling, and so cut carbon emissions.

The **Environmental Product Declarations (EPDs)** give quantified information on a product's environmental impact over its service life. PU Europe has carried out an environmental and economic life-cycle analysis of polyurethane as insulation in nearly zero-energy buildings, concluding that polyurethane is a highly efficient material solution given its low life-cycle cost.

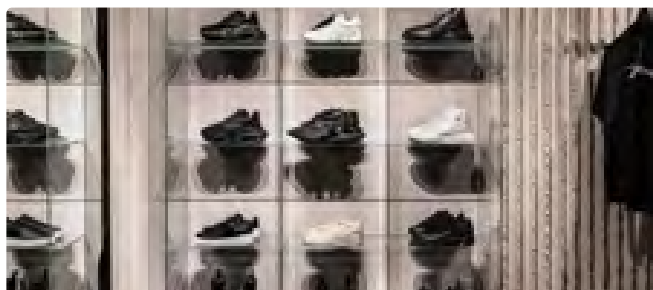
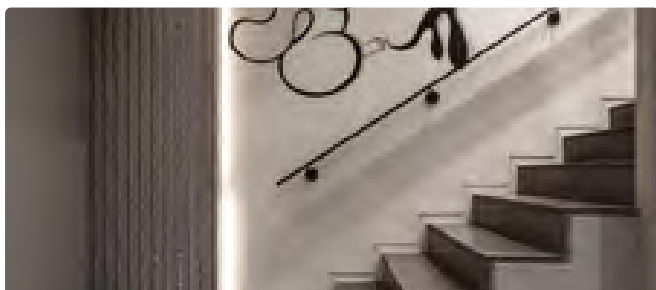
FLAME RETARDANT COATING

Por su naturaleza, el poliuretano no genera gases ni humos asfixiantes y no es tóxico en contacto con el fuego, aumentando así la protección de personas y bienes. Al mismo tiempo, los Paneles Decorativos PanelPiedra® están fabricados con un **certified fire-retardant coating under UNE standards**, which establishes that the panels do not burn and withstand temperatures of up to 80° before they begin to deform. Thanks to years of intensive research, all our products meet international fire safety standards.

6. Reducing our carbon footprint CARBON FOOTPRINT REDUCTION

Our commitment to the environment and to reducing our carbon footprint is total. We have developed an advanced climate action plan measuring the carbon footprint of recent years, which will allow us to reduce, and even neutralise, the impact of our business.
